LUNCH & SNACKS

Lunch by Signature Services - \$37.50 per week

New this summer! Let us help make your summer easier by taking the burden of making lunches off your plate! Signature Services will provide lunch throughout our GSES Summer Program! You will have the choice of a boxed lunch or a served, hot lunch. The hot lunch will include an entrée of the day, a side vegetable, and fresh fruit. In the boxed lunch, there is a daily choice between two types of sandwiches plus baked chips, fresh fruit, and a home-baked cookie. Both options include choice of low-fat milk, water, or 100% juice. A weekly menu will be available for selection during the registration process. You must pre-order lunch for the following week by Sunday night at 8:00 PM.

Campers that are staying for the entire day, and not purchasing from Signature Services, should bring sack lunches from home. Soda, energy drinks, and peanut and tree-nut products are not permitted. Since we may have students with severe peanut allergies, we maintain a strict peanut/tree-nut-free environment.

Morning and afternoon snacks are provided and do not include peanut or tree-nut products.

ARRIVALS & DEPARTURES

Early Bird Care: 8:00 - 9:00 AM

We offer an Early Bird Care Multi-Sports Camp from 8:00 - 9:00 AM for \$75 each week. When registering, please select the Early Bird Care Multi-Sports Camp and the week you need. Drop-off will be outside of Kincaid Pavilion beginning at 7:55 AM.

Morning Camp

Morning Camp students will be greeted and released from Kincaid Pavilion off the Northaven Road entrance. Morning arrivals begin at 8:55 AM, and dismissals begin at 12:00 PM.

Afternoon Camp

Afternoon Camp students will also be greeted and released from Kincaid Pavilion off the Northaven Road entrance. Afternoon arrivals begin at 12:55 PM, and dismissals begin at 4:00 PM.

*Students that are staying for both morning and afternoon camps will be safely escorted to the afternoon camp after lunch.

Extended Day Care: 4:00 - 6:00 PM

These students will be picked up from Nix.

Note: Parents are responsible for prompt student drop-off and pick-up. If your child arrives late, please walk him/her to the main entrance of the Center for Creative Learning (CCL) for check-in.
